The children have been enjoying making 'space rock cakes', learning how to measure and mix ingredients.

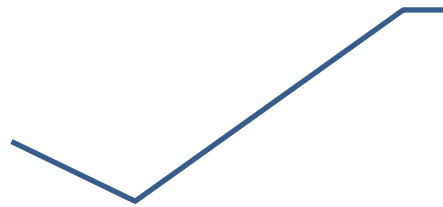

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The 2nd March will mark the start of our mission to get the community of Carleton Green thinking more carefully about our future. We are wanting as many families and friends of the school to join us over the open day to assist us with various tasks in readiness for the projects we wish to run with the children. We have two delightful little playhouses at the foot of our fields that require some TLC (carpentry skills and painting needed) to restore them to enable the children to enjoy them as the weather improves. We also have different areas allocated around our school that require some attention – the garden on the main playground, the planters on the infant playground, the Little Chicks outdoor space, the enclosed garden in front of The Wing which we intend to make into a sensory garden for children to seek space for contemplation at playtimes. We ask that if you are able to join us in this drive to get our school ready, that you come equipped with gardening tools. Refreshments will be provided. The school grounds will be open from 10:30-14:30 so please join us.

Our aim then is to plant vegetables and herbs that will then be used in our school kitchen with the sensory garden being accessed by children during lessons and playtimes. We require a greenhouse for success and have thought it would be wonderful to harness the idea of going green in its production. We are

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asking that the children start saving 1 litre plastic drinks bottles that will be used as the insulating material around a basic wooden frame (of which we are hopeful someone may be able to create for us!)

Recycling bins are to be sited around school after the 2nd March for the massive strive for collecting bottles as we anticipate requiring at least 1500 to produce the desired result. We will have a Carleton Green go Green update every week on our newsletter.
